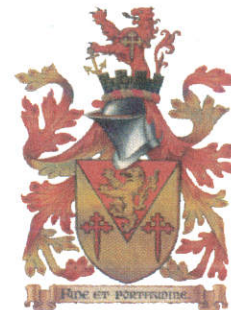

Re: World Challenge Vietnam 2017 – Build-Up Day and Airport Transfer



We write to confirm the arrangements for Build Up Day which will take place on Saturday 22nd July 2017 in Hylands Sixth Form Centre.

Challengers are asked to arrive for a prompt start at 9am. The day will finish around 3.00pm.



The Agenda for the day is as follows:

- A full kit and equipment check
- Documentation check
- Health and Hygiene briefing
- Update of medical cards
- Expedition budget briefing
- Team rules and appointment of roles

All challengers must bring with them:

- Rucksack / holdall - fully packed with everything you intend to take on expedition (as per the kit list)
- Day sack - fully packed
- Documents - Passport, 2 copies of passport photo page (and visa if applicable), 2 passport photos.

The airport transfer to Heathrow has been arranged by two of our challengers. The coach will leave the school at 7.30am on Sunday 23 July 2017 for our flight which departs at 12.25. It will return to school on Tuesday August 14th at approximately 11.30pm; our flight lands at 8.30pm. The cost of this return airport transfer is £26 which should be paid on ParentPay. All items should be obtained and no extras are allowed!


Finally our project will take place at the Centre for Nursing Old People
