

## SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE

### For Girls

Either: A blouse with skirt or trousers

Skirts

- Pleated or straight – must be black. Leather/pvc should not be worn. Minimum length will be **midway between the knee and hip** (students must take the responsibility for ensuring that skirts are at this length at all times)

Trousers

- Black. They can be boot cut, wide leg or slim cut but should be smart (no denim). **They should not be jeans (ie have rivets on the rear pockets)** and leather/pvc should not be worn. Leggings are also not allowed.

Blouses

- Free choice of colour/pattern blouse. Shoulders should be completely covered and blouses must be buttoned. They should be smart and not see-through.

Or: A Dress

Dress

- This must be black or predominantly black. A smart style with a high neck is required. Shoulders must be covered. Minimum length will be **midway between the knee and hip** (students must take the responsibility for ensuring that dresses are at this length at all times)

Both of these may be accompanied by a Jumper or Cardigan

Jumpers

- Round/v-neck jumper or Round/v-neck cardigan. Must be plain black. No hoodies or sweatshirts may be worn. **It is not acceptable to wear a jumper without a blouse underneath (ie it can be removed if requested).**

Tights or Socks must be worn

Tights/Socks

- Tights will be black or skin tone Black trainer/ankle socks are acceptable. Long socks should not be worn.

Shoes

**These should be black. No trainers or similar style is acceptable. Smart boot style shoes are allowed but Doctor Marten boots and similar styles are not deemed to be in keeping with the smart dress code.**

### For Boys

An open neck shirt with trousers

Shirts

- Free choice of colour/pattern shirt. They should be smart and must be buttoned.

#### Trousers

- Black. They should be smart (no denim). **They should not be jeans (ie have rivets on the rear pockets)**

#### This may be accompanied by a Jumper or Cardigan

#### Jumpers.

- Round/v-neck jumper or Round/v-neck cardigan. Must be plain black. No hoodies or sweatshirts may be worn. **It is not acceptable to wear a jumper without a shirt underneath (ie it can be removed if requested).**

#### Socks must be worn

#### Socks

- Black socks

#### Shoes

**These should be black. No trainers or similar style is acceptable. Smart boot style shoes are allowed but Doctor Marten boots and similar styles are not deemed to be in keeping with the smart dress code.**

#### Outerwear

- An optional black blazer style jacket with usable pockets which can be worn around school
- Any other coats or jackets will not be worn in school but can be worn to and from school. **Black leather and denim jackets should not be worn in school.**
- No hats **or scarves** will be worn in assemblies or around the school.

#### Jewellery/Hair

- A maximum of two rings or studs may be worn and only in the ear
- Hair should be a single natural colour.

#### Compulsory

- All students will be required to wear a WHSG Sixth Form embossed lanyard with photo ID card

**Students will be sent home on all occasions when they do not meet these requirements regardless of distance from school.**
