

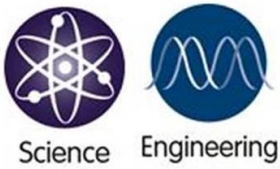

*Please send your daughter in with any medication that you wish to be kept in school in its **ORIGINAL PACKAGING** with your daughter/son's name written clearly on it.*

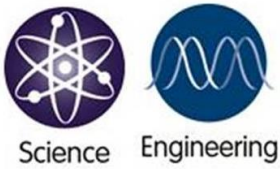
