

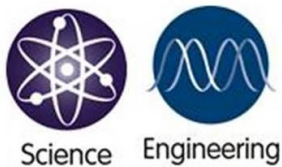

When parents/carers are contacted with regard to collecting their daughter/son from the WHSG Medical Room, the expectation is that the parent/carer will arrange for immediate collection.*

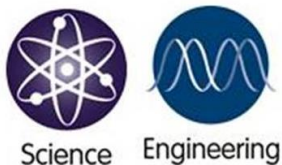
*Any student who is sent home, due to having vomited in school, must not return to school until 24 hours after the last bout of vomiting or diarrhoea.*
